




Dear Delegates,

We are hugely looking forward to seeing you at the BAMM Forum in Edinburgh on Saturday, September 30 and are very pleased to welcome those of you who have also signed up for the mosaic workshops on Sunday, October 1. The Forum promises to be a great event with a diverse range of mosaic delights to look forward to.

We would like to highlight the fact that different events are being held in different venues over the Forum weekend but they are all within Edinburgh's city centre and can be reached on foot or by a short bus ride. From the Eventbrite tickets **it might appear as if everything is being held at the University of Edinburgh's Pollock Halls but this is not the case** so it's important to read this email thoroughly if you will be attending other events in addition to the Forum. We don't want anyone to get lost!

This is an overall map of the area covered by the Forum which gives you an idea of where the venues are in relation to each other:



Edinburgh has an excellent bus network with a frequently running service so if you are intending to travel between venues by bus, please check bus times with Lothian Buses: <https://lothianbuses.co.uk/>.

If you like walking, Edinburgh is a compact city to get around; from Motel One/Waverley Station you can walk to Patriot Hall Gallery in 25 minutes, ECA and Spoon in 20 minutes and Pollock Halls in 40 minutes.


Here are the events with their addresses and locations in the order in which they will take place:

1. **BAMM Exhibition Private View**, Friday 29th September 6pm to 8pm  
PATRIOT HALL GALLERY, WASPS STUDIOS, OFF HAMILTON PLACE, STOCKBRIDGE,  
EDINBURGH, EH3 5AY



Walk down the lane to the right of Scotmid Supermarket, follow the lane around to the left, the gallery entrance has orange doors and is in the far corner.

2. **BAMM Mosaic Forum**, Saturday 30th September 9am to 6pm  
SOUTH HALL AT POLLOCK HALLS, UNIVERSITY OF EDINBURGH, [18 HOLYROOD PARK ROAD, EDINBURGH, EH16 5AR](#)



Pedestrian access can be gained through a gate from Dalkeith Road, just below the bus stop for the Commonwealth Swimming Pool.

9-10am: Forum registration, morning refreshments and the University of Edinburgh 'Handling Session' of the Paolozzi Tottenham Court Road arches mosaic fragments.

10-10.45am: BAMB AGM

The Forum will directly follow the AGM. There will be an hour break for lunch and an afternoon refreshment break, finishing at 6 to 6.30pm

3. **BAMB Forum Evening Social and Dinner**, Saturday 30th September 7pm  
SPOON, 6A NICHOLSON STREET, EDINBURGH, EH8 9DH

*The location of Spoon and its position in relation to the Forum at Pollock Halls can be seen in the first map above.*

Spoon is on the first floor. There are glass double doors at street level.

Registration at 9.30-10am will be inside the entrance to the Wee Red Bar in the glass corridor, to the right of the main (old) building in the courtyard. Vehicle entrance is via Lady Lawson Street.
